Session types and times

In addition to the two plenary lectures and the concluding roundtable discussion, the academic programme at the 30th Congress of Nordic Historians consists of 136 sessions conducted in 14–16 parallel tracks during the three main congress days 8–10 August. There are three types of sessions: thematic sessions, roundtable discussions and individual paper sessions. For the two first types, the proposers are responsible for providing a chairperson or moderator. For individual paper sessions, the organising committee will appoint a chair who helps the participants to keep time and, when needed, lead the discussion.






